Function	Can associate with other claudins to regulate tight junction structural and functional strand dynamics (PubMed: 35773259 , PubMed: 36008380). May coassemble with CLDN8 into tight junction strands containing anion-selective

channels that convey paracellular chloride permeability in renal collecting ducts (By similarity) (PubMed:[36008380](#)). May integrate into CLDN3 strands to modulate localized tight junction barrier properties (PubMed:[35773259](#), PubMed:[36008380](#)). May disrupt strand assembly of channel-forming CLDN2 and CLDN15 and inhibit cation conductance (PubMed:[35773259](#), PubMed:[36008380](#)). Cannot form tight junction strands on its own (PubMed:[35773259](#), PubMed:[36008380](#)).

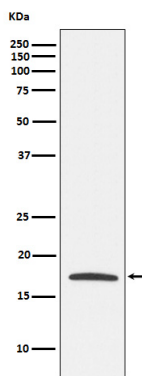
Cellular Location
