Function	Catalyzes the hydrolysis of nucleoside triphosphates (NTPs) and diphosphates (NDPs) (Probable) (PubMed: 8529670 , PubMed: 8626624 ,

The enzyme sequentially removes phosphate groups in two successive steps, converting NTPs to nucleoside monophosphates (NMPs) via NDP intermediates (Probable) (PubMed:[8529670](#), PubMed:[8626624](#), PubMed:[8955160](#), PubMed:[8996251](#)). This activity contributes to the regulation of extracellular levels of nucleotides (Probable) (PubMed:[8529670](#), PubMed:[8626624](#), PubMed:[8955160](#), PubMed:[8996251](#)). By hydrolyzing proinflammatory ATP and platelet-activating ADP to AMP, it blocks platelet aggregation and supports blood flow (PubMed:[8955160](#), PubMed:[8996251](#)).

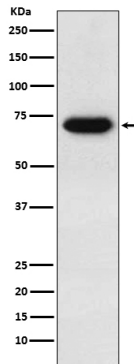
Cellular Location
