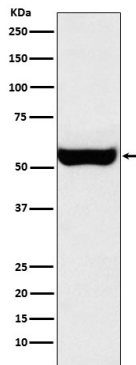

Function	Catalyzes the oxidative deamination of primary and some secondary amines such as neurotransmitters, and exogenous amines including the tertiary amine, neurotoxin 1-methyl-4-phenyl-1,2,3,6- tetrahydropyridine (MPTP), with concomitant reduction of oxygen to hydrogen peroxide and participates in

the metabolism of neuroactive and vasoactive amines in the central nervous system and peripheral tissues (PubMed:[11049757](#), PubMed:[11134050](#), PubMed:[20493079](#), PubMed:[8316221](#), PubMed:[8665924](#)).
