Function	Tyrosine-protein kinase that plays an essential role as cell surface receptor

for neuregulins. Binds to neuregulin-1 (NRG1) and is activated by it; ligand-binding increases phosphorylation on tyrosine residues and promotes its association with the p85 subunit of phosphatidylinositol 3-kinase (PubMed:[20682778](#)). May also be activated by CSPG5 (PubMed:[15358134](#)). Involved in the regulation of myeloid cell differentiation (PubMed:[27416908](#)).

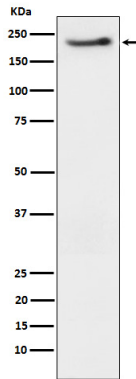
