Function	This is the non-catalytic component of the active enzyme, which catalyzes the hydrolysis of ATP coupled with the exchange of Na(+) and K(+) ions across

the plasma membrane. The beta subunit regulates, through assembly of alpha/beta heterodimers, the number of sodium pumps transported to the plasma membrane (PubMed:[19694409](#)). Plays a role in innate immunity by enhancing virus-triggered induction of interferons (IFNs) and interferon stimulated genes (ISGs). Mechanistically, enhances the ubiquitination of TRAF3 and TRAF6 as well as the phosphorylation of TAK1 and TBK1 (PubMed:[34011520](#)).

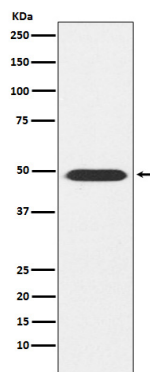
Cellular Location

Cell membrane; Single-pass type II membrane protein. Apical cell membrane {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:P07340}; Single-pass type II membrane protein. Cell membrane, sarcolemma {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:P14094}. Note=Colocalizes with OBSCN at the intercalated disk and sarcolemma in cardiomyocytes. Localizes in long striations at the level of Z and M lines {ECO:0000250|UniProtKB:P14094}
