Function	Membrane immune adherence receptor that plays a critical role in the capture and clearance of complement-opsonized pathogens by erythrocytes and monocytes/macrophages (PubMed: 2963069). Mediates the binding by

these cells of particles and immune complexes that have activated complement to eliminate them from the circulation (PubMed:[2963069](#)). Also acts in the inhibition of spontaneous complement activation by impairing the formation and function of the alternative and classical pathway C3/C5 convertases, and by serving as a cofactor for the cleavage by factor I of C3b to iC3b, C3c and C3d,g, and of C4b to C4c and C4d (PubMed:[2972794](#), PubMed:[8175757](#)). Also plays a role in immune regulation by contributing, upon ligand binding, to the generation of regulatory T cells from activated helper T cells (PubMed:[25742728](#)).

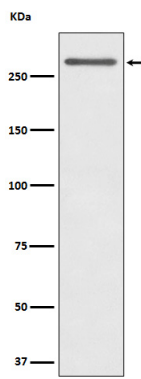
Cellular Location

Present on erythrocytes, a subset of T cells, mature B cells, follicular dendritic cells, monocytes and granulocytes
