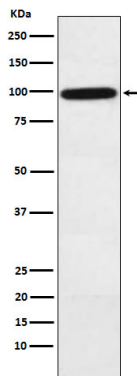

Function	Precursor of the catalytic component of the C3 and C5 convertase complexes of the alternative pathway of the complement system, a cascade of

proteins that leads to phagocytosis and breakdown of pathogens and signaling that strengthens the adaptive immune system (PubMed:[3638964](#), PubMed:[624565](#), PubMed:[6554279](#), PubMed:[6919543](#), PubMed:[9748277](#)). The alternative complement pathway acts as an amplification loop that enhances other complement pathways (classical, lectin and GZMK) by promoting formation of additional C3 and C5 convertases (PubMed:[3638964](#), PubMed:[624565](#), PubMed:[6554279](#), PubMed:[6919543](#), PubMed:[9748277](#)). CFB is cleaved and activated by CFD to generate Ba and Bb chains; Bb chain constituting the catalytic component of the C3 and C5 convertases (PubMed:[6769474](#), PubMed:[9748277](#)).
