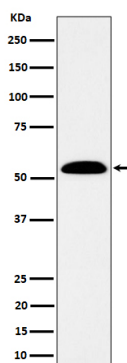

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Function	Aldehyde dehydrogenase enzyme that mediates important protective effects (PubMed: 16491085 , PubMed: 20207735 , PubMed: 20554659 , PubMed: 21338592 , PubMed: 25554827 , PubMed: 31302938 , PubMed: 31652343 , PubMed: 38604394 , PubMed: 40233740). Protects cells from oxidative stress by metabolizing a number of lipid peroxidation-derived aldehydes (PubMed: 16491085 , PubMed: 20207735 , PubMed: 21338592 , PubMed: 40233740). Involved in cellular defense against hyperosmotic stress by metabolizing betaine aldehyde to betaine, an important cellular osmolyte and methyl donor (PubMed: 20207735).
Cellular Location	[Isoform 1]: Mitochondrion
Tissue Location	Abundant in hepatoma cells and fetal cochlea, ovary, eye, heart, adrenal gland, liver and kidney. Low levels present in adult peripheral blood leukocytes and fetal brain, thymus, spleen, skeletal muscle, lung and tongue.
