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Function

Plays a key role in the repair of DNA damage, functioning as part of both the non-homologous end-joining (NHEJ) and base excision repair (BER) pathways (PubMed:[10446192](#), PubMed:[10446193](#), PubMed:[15385968](#), PubMed:[20852255](#), PubMed:[28453785](#)). Through its two catalytic activities, PNK ensures that DNA termini are compatible with extension and ligation by either removing 3'-phosphates from, or by phosphorylating 5'-hydroxyl groups on, the ribose sugar of the DNA backbone (PubMed:[10446192](#), PubMed:[10446193](#)).

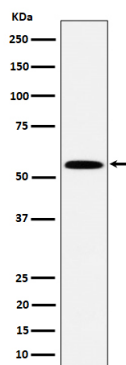
Cellular Location

Nucleus. Chromosome. Note=Localizes to site of double-strand breaks.

Tissue Location

Expressed in many tissues with highest expression in spleen and testis, and lowest expression in small intestine (PubMed:10446192). Expressed in higher amount in pancreas, heart and kidney and at lower levels in brain, lung and liver (PubMed:10446193)
