Function	Catalyzes the reduction of 7,8-dihydrofolate (DHF) to 5,6,7,8-tetrahydrofolate in a NADPH-dependent manner (PubMed: 12096917 , PubMed: 15039552 , PubMed: 17569517 , PubMed: 19196009 , PubMed: 19478082 , PubMed: 21876184 , PubMed: 9719595). Key enzyme in folate metabolism. Contributes to the nuclear and mitochondrial de novo thymidylate biosynthesis pathway (PubMed: 21876188 , PubMed: 22235121). Catalyzes an essential reaction for de novo glycine and purine synthesis, and for DNA precursor synthesis. Binds its own mRNA and that of DHFR2.
Cellular Location	Mitochondrion {ECO:0000250 UniProtKB:P00375}. Cytoplasm {ECO:0000250 UniProtKB:P00375}. Nucleus. Note=Localized to the nucleus during S and G2/M phases of the cell cycle. As a component of the de novo thymidylate synthesis complex, localizes specifically to replication forks during DNA synthesis (PubMed:22235121)
Tissue Location	Widely expressed in fetal and adult tissues, including throughout the fetal and adult brains and whole blood Expression is higher in the adult brain than in the fetal brain

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
