Function	The small GTPases Rab are key regulators of intracellular membrane trafficking, from the formation of transport vesicles to their fusion with membranes. Rabs cycle between an inactive GDP-bound form and an active GTP-bound form that is able to recruit to membranes different sets of downstream effectors directly responsible for vesicle formation, movement, tethering and fusion (PubMed: 16086013 , PubMed: 17562788). Involved in early endocytic trafficking (PubMed: 16086013 , PubMed: 17562788). Required for EEA1 recruitment to early endosomes (PubMed: 16086013 , PubMed: 17562788). Required for EGF and transferrin endocytosis and trafficking through early endosomes (PubMed: 16086013 , PubMed: 17562788).
