Function	Required for the post-translational delivery of tail-anchored (TA) proteins to the endoplasmic reticulum (PubMed: 23041287 , PubMed: 24392163 , PubMed: 27226539). Together with GET1/WRB, acts as a membrane receptor for soluble GET3/TRC40, which recognizes and selectively binds the transmembrane domain of TA proteins in the cytosol (PubMed: 23041287 , PubMed: 24392163 , PubMed: 27226539). Required for the stability of GET1 (PubMed: 32187542). Stimulates calcium signaling in T cells through its involvement in elevation of intracellular calcium (PubMed: 7522304). Essential for the survival of peripheral follicular B cells (By similarity).
Cellular Location	Endoplasmic reticulum membrane; Multi-pass membrane protein
Tissue Location	Ubiquitous. Highest levels in brain, testis and ovary
