Function	Component of the ankyrin-1 complex, a multiprotein complex involved in the stability and shape of the erythrocyte membrane (PubMed: 35835865). Mediates the primary membrane attachment site for ANK1 when associated with RHAG (PubMed: 35835865). May participate in the ammonium and carbon dioxide transport through the heterotrimer form (Probable).
Cellular Location	Membrane; Multi-pass membrane protein.

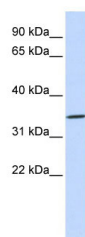
Tissue Location

Restricted to tissues or cell lines expressing erythroid characters. Isoform 4g and isoform RhPI-Alpha are expressed in immature erythroblasts but not in mature erythroblasts
