Function	Required for proper contractility of visceral smooth muscle cells (PubMed: 28292896). Mediates nucleation of actin filaments (By similarity).
Cellular Location	Cytoplasm, myofibril, sarcomere {ECO:0000250 UniProtKB:A0A0G2K0D3}. Cytoplasm, cytoskeleton {ECO:0000250 UniProtKB:A0A0G2K0D3}. Note=Colocalizes with actin filaments in sarcomeres. {ECO:0000250 UniProtKB:A0A0G2K0D3}
Tissue Location	Detected in aorta, urinary bladder and uterus (at protein level). Detected in smooth muscle cells. Detected in aorta, bladder, colon, intestine, stomach and uterus
