Function	G protein-coupled photoreceptor that selectively activates G(i) proteins in response to medium-wavelength (green) light, thereby decreasing intracellular cAMP levels (By similarity). Activation occurs when the opsin-bound cis-retinal chromophore absorbs a photon and isomerizes to all-trans-retinal, inducing a conformational change in the opsin that triggers a G protein-mediated phototransduction cascade (By similarity). Mediates visual perception of green light in cone photoreceptor cells (By similarity). May

contribute to increased spectral sensitivity under dim light conditions (PubMed:[11055434](#)).

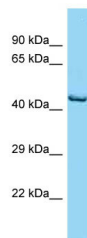
