Function	G protein-coupled receptor for CRH, UCN, UCN2 and UCN3 stress hormones, which plays a central role in whole body adaptation to stress (PubMed: 11329063 , PubMed: 11416224 , PubMed: 20966082 , PubMed: 22689579 , PubMed: 32004470 , PubMed: 36335102). Has highest affinity for UCN, and much lower affinity for CRH, UCN2 and UCN3 (PubMed: 20966082 , PubMed: 22689579 , PubMed: 32004470 , PubMed: 36335102). Ligand binding causes a conformation change that triggers signaling via guanine nucleotide-binding proteins (G proteins) and downstream effectors, such as adenylate cyclase (PubMed: 32004470 , PubMed: 36335102). CRHR2 is coupled to G(s) G protein (GNAS), mediating activation of adenylate cyclase activity and production of cAMP

(PubMed:[32004470](#), PubMed:[36335102](#)). CRHR2-dependent signaling is a primary mediator of the neuroendocrine, autonomic (fight-or-flight) and behavioral responses to stress, acting as a key regulator of adaptation by activating the hypothalamus-pituitary-adrenal axis, leading to corticotropin hormone (ACTH) production (By similarity).
