Name	ETFB (HGNC:3482)
Function	Heterodimeric electron transfer flavoprotein that accepts electrons from several mitochondrial dehydrogenases, including acyl-CoA dehydrogenases, glutaryl-CoA and sarcosine dehydrogenase (PubMed: 15159392 , PubMed: 15975918 , PubMed: 25416781). It transfers the electrons to the main mitochondrial respiratory chain via ETF- ubiquinone oxidoreductase (Probable). Required for normal mitochondrial fatty acid oxidation and normal amino acid metabolism (PubMed: 12815589 , PubMed: 7912128). ETFB binds an AMP molecule that probably has a purely structural role (PubMed: 15159392 , PubMed: 15975918 , PubMed: 8962055).
Cellular Location	Mitochondrion matrix
Tissue Location	Abundant in liver, heart and skeletal muscle. A weak expression is seen in the

brain, placenta, lung, kidney and pancreas.
