Function	Signal transducer in the Ras-MAPK signaling pathway that regulates cell proliferation and survival (PubMed: 22711838 , PubMed: 23698361). Ras proteins bind GDP/GTP and possess intrinsic GTPase activity (PubMed: 20949621 , PubMed: 39809765). Activates MAPK1/MAPK3 resulting in phosphorylation and ultimately degradation of GJA1 (By similarity). Plays a role in promoting oncogenic events by inducing transcriptional silencing of tumor suppressor genes (TSGs) in colorectal cancer (CRC) cells in a ZNF304-dependent manner (PubMed: 24623306). Recognized by LZTR1 that mediates its ubiquitination by a BCR (BTB-CUL3-RBX1) E3 ubiquitin-protein ligase complex (PubMed: 40934300).

Cellular Location	Cell membrane; Lipid-anchor; Cytoplasmic side. Endomembrane system. Cytoplasm
Tissue Location	Expressed throughout the epidermis, but weakly expressed in the stratum corneum and dermis (at protein level)
