Name TFAP2A

Synonyms AP2TF, TFAP2

Function Sequence-specific DNA-binding protein that interacts with inducible viral and

cellular enhancer elements to regulate transcription of selected genes. AP-2 factors bind to the consensus sequence 5'-GCCNNNGGC-3' and activate genes involved in a large spectrum of important biological functions including proper eye, face, body wall, limb and neural tube development. They also suppress a number of genes including MCAM/MUC18, C/EBP alpha and MYC. AP-2-alpha is the only AP-2 protein required for early morphogenesis of the

lens vesicle. Together with the CITED2 coactivator, stimulates the PITX2 P1 promoter transcription activation. Associates with chromatin to the PITX2 P1 promoter region.




Figure 1:Black line: Control Antigen (100 ng);Purple line: Antigen (10ng); Blue line: Antigen (50 ng); Red line:Antigen (100 ng)




Figure 2:Western blot analysis using TFAP2A mAb against human TFAP2A (AA: 105-211) recombinant protein. (Expected MW is 37.5 kDa)





Figure 3:Western blot analysis using TFAP2A mAb against HEK293 (1) and TFAP2A (AA: 105-211)-hIgGFc transfected HEK293 (2) cell lysate.




Figure 5:Flow cytometric analysis of Hela cells using TFAP2A mouse mAb (green) and negative control (red).
