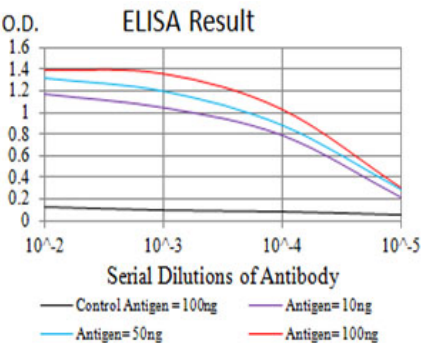


Figure 1:Black line: Control Antigen (100 ng);Purple line: Antigen (10ng); Blue line: Antigen (50 ng); Red line:Antigen (100 ng)

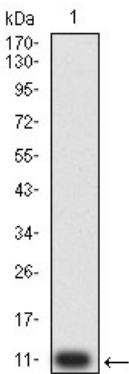


Figure 2:Western blot analysis using P2RY4 mAb against human P2RY4 (AA: extra mix) recombinant protein. (Expected MW is 10.1 kDa)

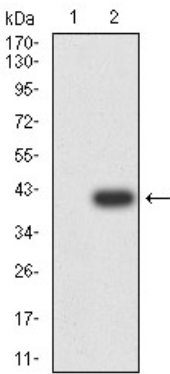


Figure 3:Western blot analysis using P2RY4 mAb against HEK293 (1) and P2RY4 (AA: extra mix)-hIgGfc transfected HEK293 (2) cell lysate.

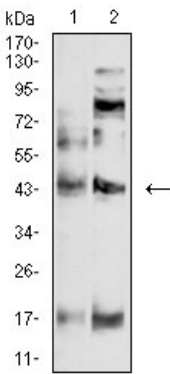


Figure 4:Western blot analysis using P2RY4 mouse mAb against SW620 (1) and A549 (2) cell lysate.

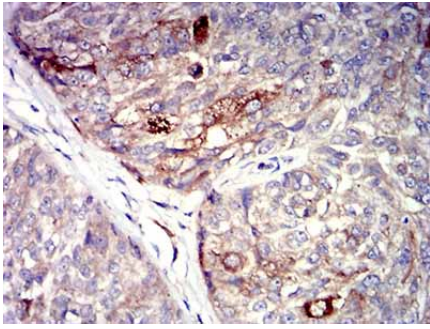
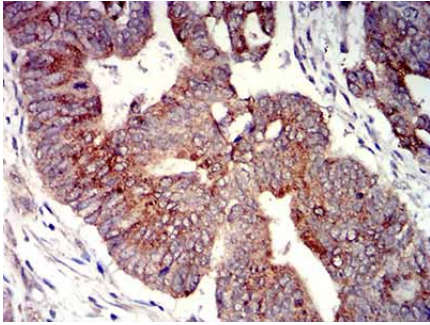


Figure 5:Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded bladder cancer tissues using P2RY4 mouse mAb with DAB staining.
