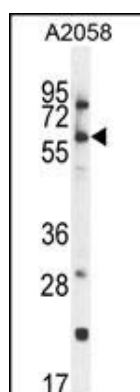

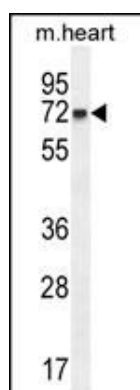

There are three different isoforms.

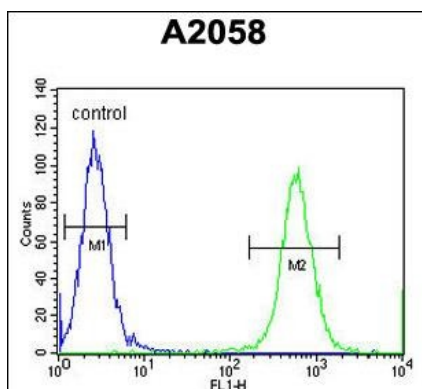
