Format	Purified polyclonal antibody supplied in PBS with 0.09% (W/V) sodium azide. This antibody is purified through a protein A column, followed by peptide affinity purification.
Storage	Maintain refrigerated at 2-8°C for up to 2 weeks. For long term storage store at -20°C in small aliquots to prevent freeze-thaw cycles.

Function	Binds and exchanges GTP and GDP. Binds and modulates the activation of POU4F1 as gene expression regulator.
Cellular Location	Nucleus. Cell membrane. Note=Colocalizes with PLXNB3 at the plasma membrane (PubMed:16122393).
Tissue Location	Neuron-specific.

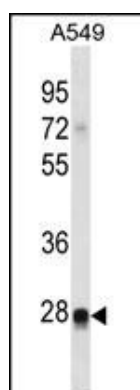
Background
