Function	Blocks the elongation and depolymerization of the actin filaments at the pointed end. The Tmod/TM complex contributes to the formation of the short actin protofilament, which in turn defines the geometry of the membrane

	skeleton.
Cellular Location	Cytoplasm, cytoskeleton. Note=In myofibrils with sarcomeric structure, localizes to the pointed end of actin thin filaments (PubMed:25250574).
Tissue Location	Highly expressed in skeletal muscle.


Background

TMOD4 blocks the elongation and depolymerization of the actin filaments at the pointed end. The Tmod/TM complex contributes to the formation of the short actin protofilament, which in turn defines the geometry of the membrane skeleton.
