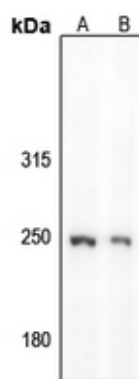

Function	Acts as a key transcription regulator of histones (PubMed: 25339177 , PubMed: 40516528 , PubMed: 40516529). Activates transcription of the histone H2A, histone H2B, histone H3 and histone H4 genes in conjunction with GON4L and MIZF (PubMed: 25339177). Together with CRAMP1, binds to the promoters of H1 genes (H1-2, H1-3, H1-4, H1-5 and H1-10/H1x), driving their transcription (PubMed: 40516528 , PubMed: 40516529). Also acts as a transcription corepressor, as part of a complex with YY1, SIN3A and HDAC1 (By similarity). Required for B- cell lymphopoiesis (By similarity).
Cellular Location	Nucleus {ECO:0000255 PROSITE-ProRule:PRU00810}. Chromosome Note=Localizes to histone locus bodies (HLB)
Tissue Location	Widely expressed..
