Synonyms	BRAF1, RAFB1
Function	Protein kinase involved in the transduction of mitogenic signals from the cell membrane to the nucleus (Probable). Phosphorylates MAP2K1, and thereby activates the MAP kinase signal transduction pathway (PubMed: <u>21441910</u> , PubMed: <u>29433126</u>). Phosphorylates PFKFB2 (PubMed: <u>36402789</u>). May play a role in the postsynaptic responses of hippocampal neurons (PubMed: <u>1508179</u>).
Cellular Location	Nucleus. Cytoplasm. Cell membrane. Note=Colocalizes with RGS14 and RAF1 in both the cytoplasm and membranes.

Background

KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide encompassing a sequence within the center region of human B-RAF. The exact sequence is proprietary.

Western blot analysis of B-RAF expression in HEK293T (A), Hela (B), H446 (C) whole cell lysates.

Immunohistochemical analysis of B-RAF staining in human liver cancer formalin fixed paraffin embedded tissue section. The section was pre-treated using heat mediated antigen retrieval with sodium citrate buffer (pH 6.0). The section was then incubated with the antibody at room temperature and detected using an HRP conjugated compact polymer system. DAB was used as the chromogen. The section was then counterstained with haematoxylin and mounted with DPX.

Immunofluorescent analysis of B-RAF staining in A431 cells. Formalin-fixed cells were permeabilized with 0.1% Triton X-100 in TBS for 5-10 minutes and blocked with 3% BSA-PBS for 30 minutes at room temperature. Cells were probed with the primary antibody in 3% BSA-PBS and incubated overnight at 4 °C in a humidified chamber. Cells were washed with PBST and incubated with a DyLight 594-conjugated secondary antibody (red) in PBS at room temperature in the dark.

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
