






Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded rat-brain, antibody was diluted at 1:100



Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded rat-brain, antibody was diluted at 1:100




Immunohistochemical analysis of paraffin-embedded rat-brain, antibody was diluted at 1:100
