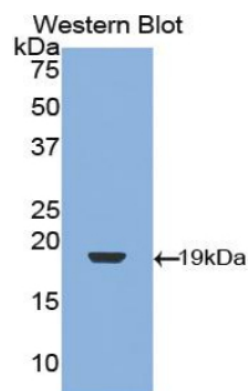


Figure. Western Blot; Sample: Recombinant TGFb1, Cavia.
