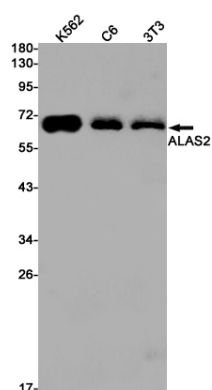

Function	Catalyzes the pyridoxal 5'-phosphate (PLP)-dependent condensation of succinyl-CoA and glycine to form aminolevulinic acid (ALA), with CoA and CO ₂ as by-products (PubMed: 14643893 , PubMed: 21252495 , PubMed: 21309041 , PubMed: 21653323 , PubMed: 32499479 , PubMed: 34492704). Contributes significantly to heme formation during erythropoiesis (PubMed: 2050125).
Cellular Location	Mitochondrion inner membrane; Peripheral membrane protein. Note=Localizes to the matrix side of the mitochondrion inner membrane.

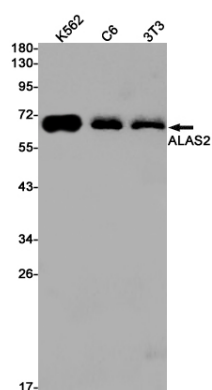
MiscellaneousThere are two delta-ALA synthases in vertebrates: an erythroid- specific form and one
