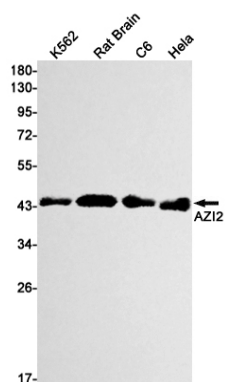

Function	Adapter protein which binds TBK1 and IKBKE playing a role in antiviral innate immunity (PubMed: 14560022 , PubMed: 21931631). Activates serine/threonine-protein kinase TBK1 and facilitates its oligomerization (PubMed: 14560022 , PubMed: 21931631). Enhances the phosphorylation of NF-kappa-B p65 subunit RELA by TBK1 (PubMed: 14560022 , PubMed: 21931631). Promotes TBK1-induced as well as TNF or PMA-induced activation of NF-kappa-B (PubMed: 14560022 , PubMed: 21931631). Participates in IFNB promoter activation via TICAM1 (PubMed: 15611223).
Cellular Location	Cytoplasm.
Tissue Location	Widely expressed (PubMed:14560022). Abundant expression seen in the pancreas and testis (PubMed:14560022)

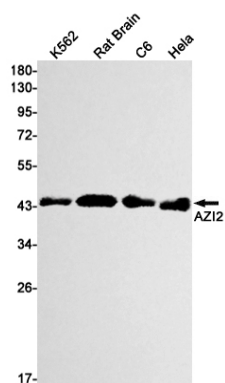
Background

AZI2, also known as NAP1, is a TNF receptor (TNFR)-associated factor family member-associated NF- κ B activator-binding kinase 1-binding protein that regulates the production of IFNs. It is an adapter protein which binds TBK1 and IKK ϵ playing a role in antiviral innate immunity.
