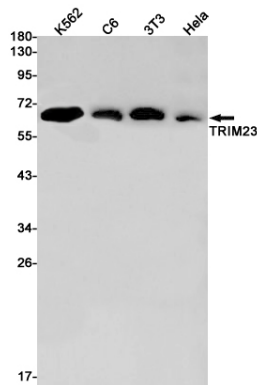

Synonyms	ARD1, ARFD1, RNF46
Function	E3 ubiquitin ligase that harbors GTPase activity encoded by the C-terminal ARF domain. Plays an essential role in autophagy activation during viral infection (PubMed: 31189704 , PubMed: 40360474). Mechanistically, activates TANK-binding kinase 1/TBK1 by facilitating its dimerization and ability to phosphorylate the selective autophagy receptor SQSTM1 (PubMed: 28871090 , PubMed: 31189704). In order to achieve this function, TRIM23 mediates 'Lys-27'-linked auto-ubiquitination of its ADP-ribosylation factor (ARF) domain to induce its GTPase activity and its recruitment to autophagosomes (PubMed: 28871090). Catalyzes 'Lys-63'-linked polyubiquitination of HAX1 that triggers its liquid- liquid phase separation (LLPS) and contributes to P-bodies assembly induced by energy stress (PubMed: 38769438).

Background

Acts as an E3 ubiquitin-protein ligase. Plays an essential role in autophagy activation during viral infection.
