Function	Signal transducer in the Ras-MAPK signaling pathway that regulates cell proliferation and survival (PubMed: 30712867). Ras proteins bind GDP/GTP and possess intrinsic GTPase activity (PubMed: 30712867). Recognized by LZTR1 that mediates its ubiquitination by a BCR (BTB-CUL3-RBX1) E3 ubiquitin-protein ligase complex (PubMed: 40934300).

Background

Ras proteins bind GDP/GTP and possess intrinsic GTPase activity. Miscellaneous Mutations which change AA 12, 13 or 61 activate the potential of Ras to transform cultured cells and are implicated in a variety of human tumors.

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
