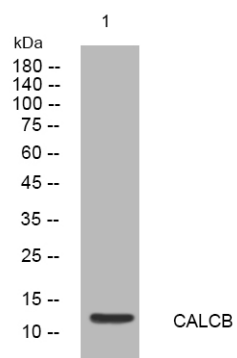

Function	CALCB/CGRP2 is a peptide hormone that induces vasodilation mediated by the CALCRL-RAMP1 receptor complex (PubMed: 1318039 , PubMed: 9620797). Dilates a variety of vessels including the coronary, cerebral and systemic vasculature. Its abundance in the CNS also points toward a neurotransmitter or neuromodulator role (PubMed: 3492492).
Cellular Location	Secreted.
Tissue Location	Expressed in spinal cord, pituitary and thalamus.
