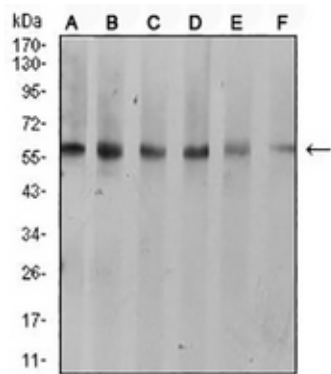

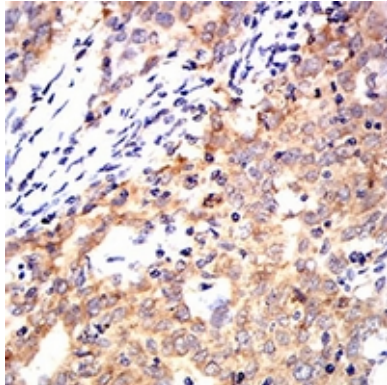

Synonyms	KPP
Function	Structural component of intermediate filaments in suprabasal keratinocytes of stratified epithelia. Forms heteropolymers primarily with the type II keratin KRT1, and also with KRT2, assembling into intermediate filament networks that support terminal differentiation, mechanical resilience, and epidermal barrier formation.
Cellular Location	Secreted, extracellular space. Cell surface. Cytoplasm
Tissue Location	Seen in all suprabasal cell layers including stratum corneum. Expressed on the surface of lung cell lines (PubMed:19627498). Localized on the surface of desquamated nasal epithelial cells (at protein level) (PubMed:12427098)

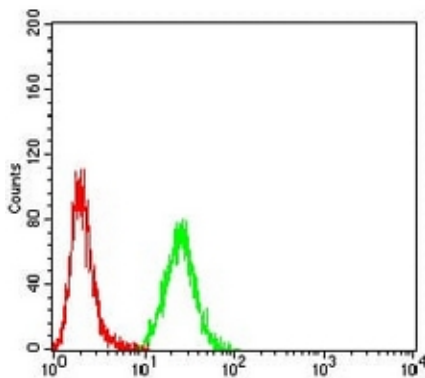

Western blot analysis of Cytokeratin 10 expression in A431 (A), C6 (B), COS7 (C), Jurkat (D), NIH/3T3 (E), HEK293 (F) whole cell lysates. (Predicted band size: 59 kD; Observed band size: 59 kD)



Immunohistochemical analysis of Cytokeratin 10 staining in human breast cancer formalin fixed paraffin embedded tissue section. The section was pre-treated using heat mediated antigen retrieval with sodium citrate buffer (pH 6.0). The section was then incubated with the antibody at room temperature and detected using an HRP conjugated compact polymer system. DAB was used as the chromogen. The section was then counterstained with haematoxylin and mounted with DPX.



Flow cytometric analysis of HeLa cells using Anti-Cytokeratin 10 Antibody (green) and negative control (red).
