Function Receptor for the cytotoxic ligand TNFSF10/TRAIL (PubMed: 10549288). The

> adapter molecule FADD recruits caspase-8 to the activated receptor. The resulting death-inducing signaling complex (DISC) performs caspase-8 proteolytic activation which initiates the subsequent cascade of caspases (aspartate-specific cysteine proteases) mediating apoptosis. Promotes the

activation of NF-kappa-B. Essential for ER stress-induced apoptosis.


Cellular Location Membrane; Single-pass type I membrane protein.

Tissue Location Widely expressed in adult and fetal tissues; very highly expressed in tumor


