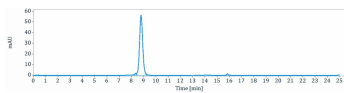
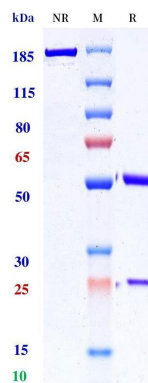

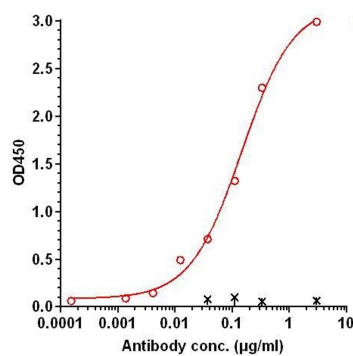

Synonyms	PALB
Function	Thyroid hormone-binding protein. Probably transports thyroxine from the bloodstream to the brain.
Cellular Location	Secreted. Cytoplasm.
Tissue Location	Detected in serum and cerebrospinal fluid (at protein level). Highly expressed in choroid plexus epithelial cells Detected in retina pigment epithelium and liver

Anti-Transthyretin Reference Antibody (coramitug) on SDS-PAGE under reducing (R) condition. The purity of the protein is greater than 95%.



The purity of Anti-Transthyretin Reference Antibody (coramitug) is 96.52%, determined by SEC-HPLC.



Immobilized hu-TTR-His at 2 µg/mL can bind coramitug, EC50= 0.1469 µg/mL.
