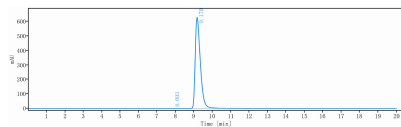
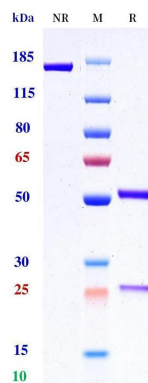

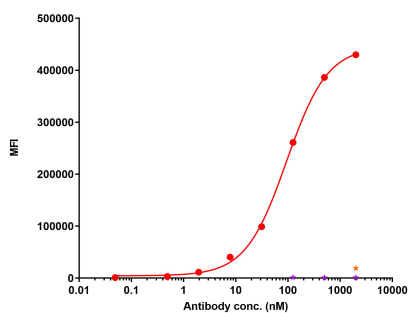
Name	TNFRSF1B
Synonyms	TNFBR, TNFR2
Function	Receptor with high affinity for TNFSF2/TNF and approximately 5-fold lower affinity for homotrimeric TNFSF1/lymphotoxin-alpha. The TRAF1/TRAF2 complex recruits the apoptotic suppressors BIRC2 and BIRC3 to TNFRSF1B/TNFR2. This receptor mediates most of the metabolic effects of TNF. Isoform 2 blocks TNF-induced apoptosis, which suggests that it regulates TNF function by antagonizing its biological activity.
Cellular Location	[Isoform 1]: Cell membrane; Single-pass type I membrane protein [Tumor necrosis factor-binding protein 2]: Secreted

Anti-TNFRSF1B / TNFR2 / CD120b Reference Antibody (HFB200301) on SDS-PAGE under reducing (R) condition. The purity of the protein is greater than 95%.



The purity of Anti-TNFRSF1B / TNFR2 / CD120b Reference Antibody (HFB200301) is 99.8%, determined by SEC-HPLC.



TNFR2-HEK293 cell line were stained with HFB200301 and negative control protein respectively, washed and then followed by PE and analyzed with FACS, with the EC₅₀ is 94.2 nM.
