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<b>Shipping Condition</b>	Ambient
<b>Purity</b>	This product was prepared from normal serum delipidation, salt fractionation, ion exchange chromatography followed by papain digestion and extensive dialysis against the buffer stated above. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-biotin, anti-Swine IgG, anti-Swine IgG F(ab') <sub>2</sub> and anti-Swine Serum. No reaction was observed against anti-Swine IgG F(c) or anti- Papain.
<b>Storage Condition</b>	Store vial at 4° C prior to restoration. For extended storage aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.
