<b>Purity</b>	This product was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography using Cat IgG coupled to agarose beads followed by solid phase adsorption(s) to remove any unwanted reactivities. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Goat Serum, Cat IgG and Cat Serum.
<b>Storage Condition</b>	Store vial at 4° C prior to restoration. For extended storage aliquot contents and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.
<b>Precautions Note</b>	This product is for research use only and is not intended for therapeutic or diagnostic applications.

## Background

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This product is designed for immunofluorescence microscopy, fluorescence based plate assays (FLISA) and fluorescent western blotting.
