<b>Application Note</b>	Anti-Mouse IgG2b secondary antibody is suitable for ELISA, Immunohistochemistry, western blotting as well as other anti IgG2b antibody based assays.
<b>Purity</b>	Anti-MOUSE IgG2b (Gamma 2b chain) Antibody was prepared from monospecific antiserum by immunoaffinity chromatography using antigens coupled to agarose beads followed by solid phase adsorption(s) to remove any unwanted reactivities. Assay by immunoelectrophoresis resulted in a single precipitin arc against anti-Goat Serum, Mouse Serum and Mouse IgG. No reaction was observed against Bovine, Human, and Rabbit Serum Proteins. Specificity was confirmed by ELISA at less than 1% of target signal.
<b>Storage Condition</b>	Store second antibody at 4° C prior to restoration. For extended storage aliquot secondary antibody and freeze at -20° C or below. Avoid cycles of freezing and thawing. Centrifuge product if not completely clear after standing at room temperature. This product is stable for several weeks at 4° C as an undiluted liquid. Dilute only prior to immediate use.
<b>Precautions Note</b>	This product is for research use only and is not intended for therapeutic or diagnostic applications.

Mouse IgG2b biotin conjugated secondary antibodies are available in a variety of formats. When choosing a secondary antibody, consideration must be given to species and immunoglobulin specificity, conjugate type, fragment and chain specificity, level of cross-reactivity, and host-species source and fragment composition.
