Calreticulins, such as CALR3, are Ca(2+)-binding chaperones localized mainly in the endoplasmic/sarcoplasmic reticulum Persson et al. (2002) [PubMed 12384296].






Antibody Reactive Against Recombinant Protein. Western Blot detection against Immunogen (65.78 KDa).




Western Blot analysis of CALR3 expression in transfected 293T cell line by CALR3 monoclonal antibody (M01), clone 4E3.
